## **NOTES**

- 1. If the TOTAL TRUE COST is (+) Positive there is still a balance owed to your school.
- 2. If the TOTAL TRUE COST is (-) Negative there may be a refund owed to your studnet.
- 3. If the refund is a result of loans, consider if these extra funds are necessary. If not, instruct your FA Officer to refund any amount not needed.
- 4. The sum of all awards may **NOT** exceed your Award Year's Total COA.

Work-study is a part-time student employment program, typically limiting hours to 20 per week. It provides financial aid via a "wage" through student jobs, allowing students to earn up to their awarded amount per term.

Be aware of GROSS vs NET loan amounts. An oversight here can create a funding gap. For TRUE COST purposes always use the NET loan amounts here.
